Of very ancient origins it has been an important and fortified village since Roman times for its strategic position. Thanks to its natural and artistic beauties Dervio is one of the most important tourist destinations in the area of Lake Como. It is considered the **"Paradise of Sailing"**, loved by sailors, windsurfer and kitesurfer from all over the world, thanks to its position that makes its shores always windy. The lake promenade of considerable extension, with numerous beaches and the pedestrian path surrounded by greenery offers a natural and equipped space where you can relax and play sports admiring a beautiful landscape. The mountains surrounding Dervio, guarantees plenty of outdoor hiking and cycling suitable for everyone in an enchanting and uncontaminated panorama, up to the peaks of **Monte Legnoccino**, **Monte Muggio** and **Monte Legnone** (2,610 m asl) or along the path **"Sentiero del Viandante"**. 

One Thousand Steps Village

The village of Corenno Plinio is one of the most characteristic corners of Lake Como, a place where you can experience a strong historical suggestion and imagine the events of the lake during the Middle Ages. The medieval village develops around the castle and the church located on the promontory. The patrician villas, the ancient houses, the arcades and the decorations that are found along the alleys make it a unique and unrepeatably place. Along the ancient steps carved into the rock down to the lake you can reach the ancient pier with a small and beautiful beach with a spectacular view on Lake Como, where you can admire stunning sunsets.






Every year in August the event of Historical Re-enactment **"Medieval in Corenno Plinio"** is organised. The alleys of the village are populated by royal women and knights creating a atmospheres of other times.



Orezia Tower

On a cliff overlooking the village, the Orezia Tower was built in the late Middle Ages to block the Valvarrone road. It was originally part of a village with a castle, of which today remain arcades and ancient houses with a church. The tower is open to the public on weekends from May to September and from its summit you can admire a beautiful view of Dervio and Lake Como.



Sailing Paradise

Dervio with its 3 kilometers of swimming beaches, is a perfect summer destination. Considered the Paradise of Sailing, it's a destination for water sports enthusiasts, who can try their hand at the waves in every season of the year, thanks to the "Breva" and "Tivan" winds that never fail and to the numerous sailing, windsurfing and kitesurfing schools located in town. Thanks to the excellent geographical position always windy, it's often home to national and international competition.



Waterpark of Dervio

The only Water Park of Lake Como, an oasis of wellness and relaxation, where you can spend with family and friends a day Full of fun and carefree. The Acquapark is composed of various inflatable structures anchored directly in the lake just a few metres from the shore, measuring more than 800 square meters of slides and trampolines. All crowned by a breathtaking view and a green area with bar on the beach and equipped with sun beds and umbrellas.

Sentiero del Viandante

The area of Dervio is crossed by one of the most beautiful hiking routes of Italy, the **Sentiero del Viandante**, the ancient road connecting Lecco and Valtellina. The proposed itineraries that have as their starting point Dervio, gather in the space of a few hours, the best of the landscape features of the territory, with breathtaking views, geological peculiarities and historical evidence, through woods, villages and rural houses.
